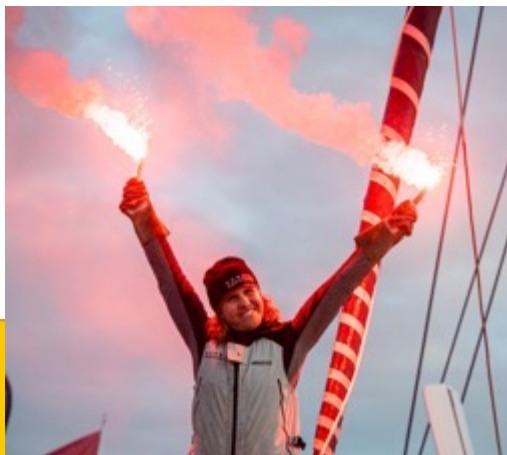

February 2023

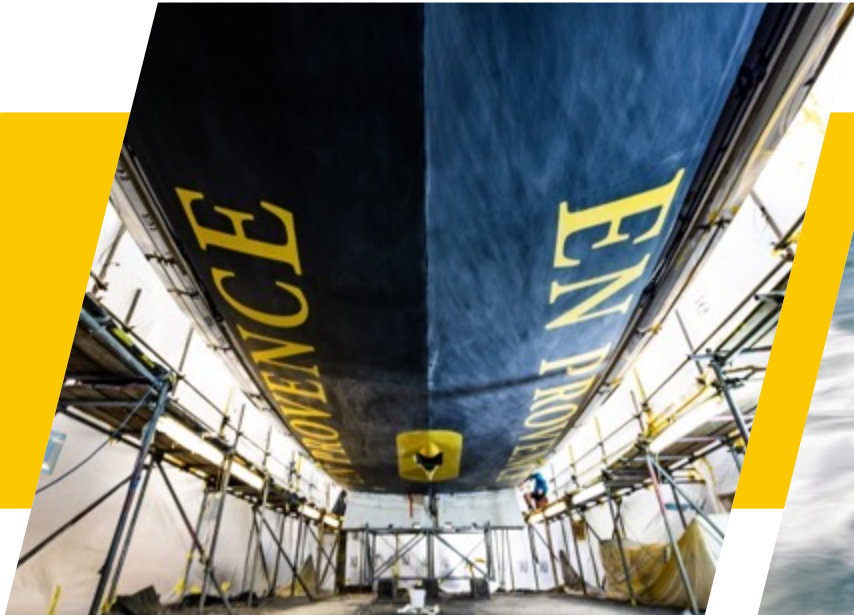
Clarisse is **dropped** by her previous sponsor for **unfounded reasons**.
